

INSTRUCTIONS & WARNINGS

LIMITED WARRANTY

Brain Pad, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "the company") warrants to the original purchaser ("Purchaser") of these "PRO+" series protectors ("PRO+") that the PRO+ shall be free from defects in material and workmanship which could result in damage, loss, or injury to normal natural teeth of the Purchaser when properly used in supervised athletic contests or coach-supervised training sessions within the United States of America. This Warranty shall extend for a period of 6 months from the date of purchaser's original purchase at retail, and is not transferable and/or assignable. Dental warranty does not apply to Mixed Martial Arts participants that do not wear conventional boxing gloves approved by national or international boxing standards. The company's liability for a defective PRO+ is expressly and solely limited to (i) the replacement of the PRO+; or (ii) the lesser of (a) actual dental expenses incurred by the Purchaser; or (b) the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$375) per injured or replaced tooth, up to maximum liability of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) per incident; provided, however, the company's obligations under the immediately preceding sentence shall be reduced by the amount of any insurance collected is payable to Purchaser for the damage, loss, and/or injury claimed by Purchaser on account of the PRO+.

Notwithstanding any other provision in the Warranty to the contrary, (i) this Warranty does not provide or shall be deemed to provide payment or indemnity for orthodontic treatments or preparation of the tooth to be used as an anchor for a bridge, (ii) the company shall have no responsibility or liability whatsoever under this Warranty unless (a) the PRO+ was fitted by Purchaser in accordance with the printed instructions accompanying this Warranty; and (b) a complete written notice from Purchaser of the injury, loss and/or damage is received by the company within thirty (30) days after the occurrence of the injury, loss, and/or damage ("Notice") addressed to Brain-Pad, Inc. Warranty Department, 322 Fayette St., Conshohocken, Pennsylvania, 19428; (c) Notice is substantiated by a statement of a licensed dentist providing necessary dental treatment within thirty (30) days after the date of injury, loss, and/or damage, together with a statement of (1) participating game official, if the injury, loss, and/or damage occurred during a supervised contest, or (2) supervising coach or school superintendent, if the injury, loss, and/or damage occurred during a practice session, as the case may be, that the PRO+ was properly used at the time the injury, loss, and/or damage occurred; (d) the PRO+ is returned to the company with the Notice; and (e) you supply reasonable proof of your date of the PRO+ purchase along with the original warranty/instruction sheet included with your purchased PRO+. The PRO+ shall become the sole and exclusive property of the company upon the company's receipt of it.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY SET FORTH ABOVE IN THIS WARRANTY, BRAIN-PAD SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO PURCHASER OR ANY OTHER PERSON FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, DAMAGES, LOSSES, EXPENSES OR INCONVENIENCE, WHETHER DIRECT OR INDIRECT, AND WHETHER ARISING OUT OF A BREACH OF WARRANTY, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR TORT. MOREOVER, THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER ANY DAMAGE, LOSS AND/OR INJURY ARISING FROM NON-SUPERVISED ATHLETIC CONTESTS AND/OR NON COACH-SUPERVISED TRAINING SESSIONS. IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY IMPOSED ON THE SALE OF THIS MOUTHGUARD UNDER STATE LAW ARE LIMITED TO ONE (1) YEAR DURATION. SOME STATES DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS ON HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS, AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER RIGHTS WHICH VARY FROM STATE TO STATE. THIS WARRANTY ONLY APPLIES TO PRODUCTS SOLD AT RETAIL.

POTENTIAL PROBLEMS

PRO+ Mouthguard won't fit all the way into the mouth.	
PRO+ Mouthguard is hard to cut with scissors.	
After being boiled, the lower flange folded in and lower teeth don't fit into channel.	
A flange is folded in and won't spread open or the airway space has closed.	
I followed the "boil and bite" process but the PRO+ Mouthguard does not show teeth imprints.	
I'm starting to gag after a few seconds or minutes.	
I'm salivating more than usual.	
The inner core or the outer plastic is split or the back flanges are flattened out.	

RECOMMENDATIONS

Cut off small back portions at sizing lines with scissors (see illustrations). Do this in stages and don't cut too much. The channels must extend to the back of the last molars. Never cut in front of Line C on Adult model or Line B on Junior model as this will ruin the PRO+ Mouthguard. The PRO+ Mouthguard is more pliable when boiled.
Use large scissors. Be persistent and continue to apply pressure with scissors; all at once the scissors will cut through. Or, carefully cut with a sharp knife on a cutting board. Trim/round back corners of flanges for smooth edges. Minors - Have an adult cut the PRO+ Mouthguard.
You can fit, or re-fit, the PRO+ Mouthguard if the damage is not too great. Follow the boil instructions carefully. Spread flanges open with thumbs, insert the PRO+ Mouthguard and bite to re-fit.
If the PRO+ Mouthguard was left in boiling water too long or if it has been otherwise damaged, discard and replace it and start over. Watch boiling times and instructions more closely.
The water did not reach the boiling temperature, the PRO+ Mouthguard may have cooled too much before biting, or you may not have bitten down hard enough. Completely cool with cold water and repeat the "boil and bite" process.
Gagging may have serious consequences. Gradually trim the inside back of the lower flanges (not channels) until the gag response stops.
There may be a tendency to salivate more until you adjust to the PRO+ Mouthguard. This tendency usually subsides by the 3rd or 4th use.
Excessive stress, clenching or 'chewing' may split or flatten the thermoformed plastic. If this happens, especially to the inner core or back flanges, immediately discard and replace the PRO+ Mouthguard. Structural damage destroys essential features of the product.

⚠ WARNING ⚠

- The mouth, teeth, jaw-joint (TMJ), and brain are vulnerable to injury in contact sports. When custom fitted and used properly, the PRO+ Mouthguard is intended to reduce certain risks of injury (cut lips from users teeth, tooth loss or damage), but may not eliminate such risks and does not guarantee protection against them.
- Do not use the PRO+ Mouthguard if you have an under-bite (Class III prognathic jaw relationship in which the lower teeth are positioned in front of the upper teeth when the mouth is closed) as the PRO+ Mouthguard will reposition your jaw inward instead of outward, thereby increasing your risk of injury. See your dentist.
- Read the following instructions carefully; failure to do so may result in damage to the PRO+ Mouthguard and compromise the margins of protection the PRO+ Mouthguard provides.
- Do not use if poorly fitted or damaged, if the air opening is too small, or if any material, including the inner core, is split or flattened; these conditions may eliminate the product's functional and/or protective features.
- Trim the PRO+ Mouthguard as directed if you have a gag response. Gagging may cause vomiting and/or serious damage to the esophagus.
- Consult a doctor if you have been exposed to possible head/brain injury. Past, present, and undetected injuries, may contribute to serious individual or cumulative injury, disability, or death.
- Consult a dentist if you have concerns about special dental needs, including orthodontic appliances.
- Avoid extreme temperatures that will damage the PRO+ Mouthguard. Excessive heat causes softening and distortion. Excessive cold causes hardening and brittleness.

Failure to attach strap correctly negates 'quick-release strap' safety design functionality, effectiveness and can cause injury !

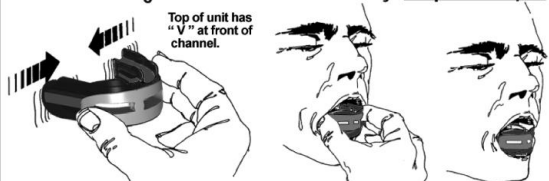

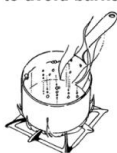
Product must be custom fitted. Minors should have adult supervision.

Test Fit For Length. Place on lower teeth only. Keep mouth open.

Proper handling for sizing. Lower front teeth determine length.

Perfect fit. Lower teeth and molars must fit in channel.**Slightly too large. Cut lines (A).****Too large. Cut lines (B).****Trim for Length if needed: Use larger scissors - Be careful!****Trim/Round all corners for comfort.****Insert string through the Strap Attachment Hole - located on the side of the post in the breathe space.****Strap clasp fits tightly. TURN ball end of clasp 1/4 turn while applying strong pressure when connecting strap ends.****Fully Insert: Breathe space boiling support piece. (included in case).****Bring water to rapid boil; then turn off heat to avoid burns.**

* Remove support piece only AFTER fitting & cooling guard.

Place in water up to boil line.

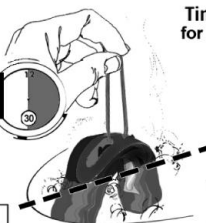
Place in water completely.

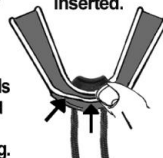

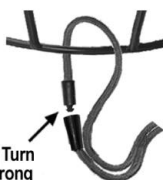
Place in water up to boil line.

DO NOT OVER BOIL**Time critical in seconds. for HIGH PERFORMANCE Model: WPR-300****SECOND STAGE 15 SECONDS**

Place in water completely.

OVER 45 SECONDS TOTAL DESTROYS THE HP WPR-300**Shake off excess water.****Leave Strap Attachment inserted.****Lower front flange may curl in.****Use thumbs to open curled channels (check Top and Bottom) before Molding.****Leave Strap Attachment and insert in place to mold!****Bite down slowly to insure teeth fit in upper channel.****Open mouth, slightly extending the lower jaw forward.****Place on lower teeth.****Bite down to imprint teeth.****!CAUTION!****IF you have BRACES, BRACKETS or APPLIANCES on your teeth, SKIP the following BOXED Step.****DO NOT MOLD OUTSIDE SURFACES INTO BRACES BRACKETS or APPLIANCES!****Mold to mouth (like sucking a lemon). Use fingers to mold outside surfaces to teeth & gums. Use tongue to mold inside surfaces.****Remove & rinse with cool water.****Remove breathe space boiling support piece.****Check fit.**

Carefully Re-boil if necessary.

PROPER STRAP ATTACHMENT: IMPORTANT!:**DO NOT TIE or WRAP ANY part of attachment strap or string! Doing so, can negate Safety Release clasp's effectiveness.****Proper FACE MASK Attachment****Turn Ball End 1/4 Turn while applying strong pressure.****Pass strap attachment UNDER top shoulder pad breast plate lacing.****- or -****NEVER tie the strap attachment system!****CARE & CLEANING:****ENJOY THE BRAIN-PAD's: POWER, PROTECTION & INCREASED BREATHING!**

- Keep your Brain Pad & storage case clean. Store the Brain Pad in its case when not in use.
- Wash the Brain Pad after each use in lukewarm water. Hot water may soften & distort the Brain Pad.
- Sanitize regularly with an astringent mouthwash for good hygiene.
- With proper care, your Brain-Pad should provide protection for a whole season.
